



Free basket shoot off.

This is included in for free at the end of the tournament there will be a throw off for all Am players to claim the free basket. The order you sign up is the order in which we will play for the free basket. There is only one basket to give away so if somebody aces the basket it is theirs to take home and the play off ends. There will be no second chances. If nobody aces the basket, it travels to the next event. Ya got to be in it to win it.

The Traveling Ace Fund

To claim the Traveling Ace Fund you must ace a hole in regulation play and have paid to enter the fund. If no paying players has aced during regulation play, Paying players who have entered are eligible after regulation play for a one shot play off If nobody still gets an ace, the ace fund will travel to our next tour stop. Penalties and OB's

Out of Bounds is the plain that either by imagination or physical means has been deemed as an unplayable part of the course. Any shot that stays across this line is considered out of bounds.

Crossing out of bounds and not returning;

If this happens a one stroke penalty will be added and you must then take a drop where the disc last crossed bounds.

A Drop; A drop is taken when a shot has been deemed unplayable. To take a drop you apply a stroke penalty and place your marker no more than one meter from that occurrence. With the exception of a hanging lie.

Hanging lie. Any lie caught 3 meters or 6'6" above ground is out of bounds. If this happens take a lie directly under the hanging lie, add a stroke, play on.

Any disc that lands on or over any road is out of bounds. This includes parking lots. If this happens play it from where it last crossed the plain of bounds. A 1-meter drop is allowed. Add a stroke. Play on.

Any disc that is lost for more then 3 minutes is considered out of bounds. Add a stroke, play it from where it was last seen inbounds.

Any disc completely surrounded by water is out of bounds. Play it from where it crossed the plain

of the water and land. A 1-meter drop is allowed. Add a stroke. Play on

If you are touching any part of the bound plain you are inbounds. .

Marking your lie

You must use a mini marker disc to mark your lie (shot).

To mark your lie, place a marker directly between your disc and the basket and play with one foot directly behind it.

If you don't have a mini marker we have markers for sale.

Order of play

During play the player that received the lowest score from the previous hole. Tees first

The order of play going into the first round is determined by a shuffle of cards. (99.99% of the time you will play only within your designated division).

The second round you will be grouped with other players in your own division that shot as close to a similar score as yours.

In the event of playoffs tee order will first be determined by lowest second round score if that score is the same it will go alphabetical by last name then first name.

Putting

When putting from inside 30' the player must show balance until the disc is resting still in the basket. Or the putt may be considered a falling putt and a stroke will be added for each occurrence.

But the stroke may only be added after a first warning has been given by two or more players. Or an official.

Rulings

First see if the group can come up with a ruling. If the group can not come up with a ruling on it's own. Your group must take a time and find an official. Remember the benefit of the doubt always goes to the player.

Courtesy

Courtesy violations, are allowed one warning. After a warning has been declared a one stroke penalty shall occur. Courtesy violations are but not limited to, ringing cell phones, Verbally or physically distracting a player during their turn, littering is also a violation. Please contact an official if there is a concern.
